Tax Incentives – A New Standard?

Thailand now offers two new tax incentives which are possibly amongst the best incentives in the ASEAN region. These incentives have some attractive tax benefits but also contain a number of conditions to achieve the full advantages offered by them. Attendance at this seminar will enable you to assess the merits of establishing a Regional Operating Headquarters and/or an International Procurement Centre in Thailand. There will also be the comparative advantage of Thailand vs. other major ASEAN countries for such ROH operations and incentives (vs. Singapore, Malaysia or Vietnam). A detailed analysis of the technical conditions will enable international companies to make decisions whether or not to restructure their businesses to achieve the tax benefits offered under these schemes.
