THAILAND

Thailand's New Leader Anutin Set to Push Growth and Calm Border Crisis

Thailand's new Prime Minister **Anutin Charnvirakul** pledged to tackle the nation's economic problems, resolve the border conflict with Cambodia through diplomacy, and pursue a new, more democratic constitution. In his inaugural address to Parliament, **Anutin** reaffirmed his commitment to holding a referendum for an elected constituent assembly to draft the new charter and to upholding the constitutional monarchy. He also vowed to fight corruption and crime while restoring public trust and happiness. He emphasized the importance of unity and collaboration among all political parties and citizens to drive Thailand toward stability, prosperity, and lasting peace.

New Thai Government Aiming to Present Key Policy Statement Before Sept 30, Official Says

Thailand's incoming government plans to deliver its policy statement to Parliament to enable the use of 50-60 billion baht (\$1.57-\$1.89 billion) from the current fiscal year's budget to stimulate the economy, according to **Siripong Angkasakulkiat**, deputy leader of the ruling *Bhumjaithai Party*. The policy announcement, expected between September 29 and 30, marks the official start of the new administration. If delayed beyond the fiscal year's end, the unused funds would return to the treasury. The government aims to boost short-term economic recovery, addressing challenges such as U.S. tariffs, high household debt, and a strengthening baht.

Thailand Records 7.44% y/y Drop in Foreign Visitors So Far in 2025

By 21 September, Thailand recorded ~23.45 million foreign visitors in 2025 year-to-date, marking a 7.44% drop compared to the same period in 2024.

Thailand's Export Growth Slows As U.S. Tariffs Bite

Thailand's exports grew by 5.8% in August, marking the slowest pace in nearly a year, according to the Commerce Ministry. The weaker performance was attributed to a stronger baht and the effects of U.S. tariffs. The growth fell short of the 9.5% increase forecast in a Reuters poll and followed an 11% rise in July. Despite the slowdown, the ministry expressed confidence that full-year export targets could still be achieved.

Thailand's New Government Pledges Economic Fixes as Fitch Cuts Outlook

Thailand's new government pledged to revive the struggling economy while maintaining fiscal discipline, following a credit outlook downgrade by Fitch Ratings. The agency revised Thailand's outlook from "stable" to "negative", citing rising fiscal risks and ongoing political uncertainty. Prime Minister **Anutin Charnvirakul** downplayed the move, saying the downgrade reflected past factors, and vowed swift action to strengthen economic performance.

ITALY

Italy Close to Exiting EU's Excess Deficit Procedure

Christine Lagarde on Italy's Fiscal Outlook European Central Bank President **Christine Lagarde** recently stated that Italy is nearing an exit from the EU's excessive deficit procedure, thanks to its improving fiscal position. The country is on track to reduce its budget deficit to 3% of GDP by 2025, a year earlier than previously anticipated. This improvement is attributed to higher-than-expected tax revenues, which have bolstered the government's fiscal position. Economy Minister **Giancarlo Giorgetti** has indicated that Italy could meet this target by 2025, potentially exiting the EU procedure a year ahead of schedule. An updated forecast on Italy's economy, debt, and deficit figures is expected soon through the country's Document of Economy and Finance (DEF).

Italy Ranks Europe's Leading Exporter of Cheese to Non-EU Markets

In the first half of 2025, Italy became Europe's top cheese exporter, with over 97,600 tons shipped to non-EU countries worth nearly one billion euros. This achievement highlights the dairy sector's ability to blend tradition and innovation to meet global demand. Exports grew notably in South Korea (+40.8%), Saudi Arabia (+28.4%), Canada (+18.9%), Norway (+9.3%), and the UK (+5.7%), showing rising appreciation for the quality of Italian cheeses and creating new opportunities for producers worldwide.

OTHER COUNTRIES

Morning Brief: Nestlé Faces a Sticky Situation - Much Like Inflation in the Eurozone

European markets await the euro zone's latest inflation report, expected to show prices holding steady at 2% in August, in line with the ECB's target and unchanged interest rates. Investor attention is also on Nestlé after the company abruptly fired CEO Laurent Freixe for failing to disclose a relationship with a subordinate. The dismissal marks another leadership shake-up following last year's CEO departure and the chairman's plan to step down in 2026. Nestlé shares have dropped 17% over the past year, compared to a 5% rise in the STOXX 600.

Market Jitters: Stocks Rise, Dollar Falls as U.S. Shutdown Threat Grows

Global stocks rose and the dollar weakened on Monday as investors prepared for a potential U.S. government shutdown that could delay key data, including the September payrolls report. Gold climbed to a record high, fueled by safe-haven demand and a softer dollar, while U.S. and European markets posted modest gains — the S&P 500 up 0.3%, the Nasdaq 0.5%, the Dow 0.2%, and Europe's STOXX 600 0.2%. Despite the looming deadline, investors remained calm, recalling the limited market impact of previous shutdowns. Analysts said a brief closure would have little effect on growth but a prolonged one could hinder the Federal Reserve's policy outlook ahead of its October meeting, where markets still expect a likely rate cut.







"INTRavers8" – A SOLO EXHIBITION BY GIANLUCA VERNIZZI

About the exhibition

The Museum of Contemporary Art (MOCA BANGKOK) is excited to present **INTRavers8**, a solo exhibition by Italian entrepreneurial artist **Gianluca Vernizzi**. Curated by **Camilla Russell**, this collection of new paintings celebrates humanity's desire to find meaning in a cacophony of shapes and symbols. **Vernizzi** believes that creative expression is inherently individualistic and resonates differently with everyone based on their own *"frequency and chemistry."* Artistic appreciation thrives in subjectivity—the ephemeral nature of an individual's relationship to a work of art is where patterns and affinities originate.

INTRavers8 is a linguistic fusion of the words *"introvert"* and *"universe,"* and a wordplay on *"1 Universe to the Power of Infinity."* The exhibition invites viewers to embark on a vibrant visual journey that draws from art history, science, and technological innovation. **Vernizzi's** inspirations include fractal geometry, epigenetics, and quantum physics, as well as the exploration of scientific materials in art. Where technology offers ingenuity, traditional painting techniques provide grounding and depth—merging to form a new humanistic chapter in visual storytelling.

Among the highlights is *Life is a Soup and I am a Fork*, a diptych that boldly combines traditional portraiture with LED technology. The textured oil painting evokes the Western art canon, while the integration of LED components elevates the viewing experience to an experimental plane. Another standout work, *Blueprint*, is a lyrical abstract painting that



references linguistics through cursive linear brushstrokes within a haunting blue-and-yellow landscape.

All of the artwork titles are inspired by the artist's personal relationships and meaningful memories. While the works may reference the language of traditional art history—both figurative and abstract—the titles themselves offer an intimate glimpse into the artist's private world, much like entries in a diary that reflect fleeting experiences and epigenetic shifts.

INTRavers8 invites viewers into an arresting visual *"theatre"* filled with mesmerizing signs and symbols. It celebrates humanity's unique ability to search for meaning even amidst apparent chaos—this intrinsic *"magic"* of finding patterns where none exist is what the artist finds most uplifting.

About the artist

Gianluca Vernizzi is an Italian multidisciplinary artist educated in the UK and USA. He holds a degree in Industrial Psychology and completed the *Birthing of Giants* executive program at MIT. Over a career spanning more than 40 years, he has pioneered environmentally conscious 3D spatial color technologies for architecture and incorporated nano-materials into his art to explore themes of impermanence and transformation.

He is the founder of *Fractalis* and *Bodhi*, design brands focused on architectural innovation and horology. In 2017, *Bodhi* commemorated the *Chulalongkorn Centenary* with a limited-edition timepiece designed by **Vernizzi**. His work has been exhibited internationally, including at the Thailand *Biennale Korat* (2021) and in solo shows across Bangkok, China, and Italy. He currently lives and works in Bangkok, Thailand.

About the curator

Camilla Russell is a Thai-American curator with over 15 years of experience in the commercial creative sector, spanning international auctions, art gallery management, and hospitality. She holds a Master's Degree in Art Business from Sotheby's Institute of Art, New York City. Her notable roles include Southeast Asian Art Specialist at Sotheby's Hong Kong, PR Manager at Mandarin Oriental, Bangkok, and Lifestyle Journalist at the Bangkok Post. She currently resides and works in Bangkok, Thailand.
